Tasks

- Promote the personal growth of the gymnasts of the WAG National Squad
- Prepare the gymnasts to major international competitions and to national and international competitions, tournaments and training camps
- Accompany the gymnasts at major international competitions and at national competitions, tournaments and training camps
- Plan customized trainings on the short, medium and long term
- Promote the athletes' soft skills
- Make sure that the collaboration and communication with coaches, medical staff, sport science et team management run well
- Collaborate at senior gatherings and coaches instructions
- Exchange with sports bases and provide them with a technical support

Requirements

- A coach certificate at the highest level (Switzerland: SGF coach diploma 3 (DTLG), France: diplôme d'État supérieur de la jeunesse, de l'éducation populaire et du sport (DESJEPS), Germany: coach diploma from the Köln Academy or equivalent education)
- Several years of professional experience as a Women's Artistic Gymnastics coach with a track record of success at a high international level
- Strong communication and social skills and ethically correct behaviour
- Good, or even very good, knowledge of German and/or French (learning another national language (German or French) with diploma may be required)
- Interest to get to know the Swiss sports and gymnastics system
- Patience and understanding towards the gymnasts and their individual needs
